### **NeuroFaith® Therapist Certification Agreement**

This Therapist Certification Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into between NeuroFaith® LLC, founded and directed by **Dr. Jeffrey E. Hansen, PhD**, and:

#### **Preamble: The NeuroFaith® Model**

NeuroFaith® is an integrative model of human healing and transformation that brings together neuroscience, trauma-informed clinical care, and faith-centered spiritual formation. It is grounded in the understanding that lasting healing occurs through the restoration and integration of the mind, body, and soul.

The NeuroFaith® model draws from established principles and frameworks, including Polyvagal-informed theory, HeartMath® / neurocardiology, and Internal Family Systems (IFS), integrated in alignment with spiritual formation. These components are not applied in isolation, but as part of a unified and coherent clinical approach.

The model is not intended for superficial or partial use, but for meaningful integration into the therapeutic process, with the aim of fostering deep and enduring transformation.

#### **Scope of Certification**

This certification authorizes the Therapist to incorporate the NeuroFaith® model into their clinical work, consistent with their professional licensure, training, and scope of practice.

The Therapist acknowledges that NeuroFaith® is to be applied within the bounds of ethical and legal standards governing their profession and is not a substitute for appropriate clinical judgment.

#### **Standards of Integrity and Clinical Application**

The Therapist agrees to uphold the integrity of the NeuroFaith® model in both understanding and application. This includes utilizing the model in a manner that reflects its full integrative intent, rather than reducing it to isolated techniques or fragmented interventions.

### **Representation and Professional Responsibility**

The Therapist agrees that any reference to the NeuroFaith® model in professional materials, communication, or representation shall accurately reflect its nature and scope.

The Therapist agrees to properly credit Dr. Jeffrey E. Hansen, PhD as the Founder and Director of NeuroFaith® when referencing the model in a professional context.

The Therapist further agrees not to represent themselves as the originator of the model or to present modified versions of the model as equivalent to NeuroFaith®.

### **Informed Consent, Non-Affiliation, and Client Disclosure**

The Therapist agrees to include, within their informed consent documentation, a clear written statement disclosing the nature and limits of their relationship to the NeuroFaith® model.

Such disclosure shall state that Dr. Jeffrey E. Hansen, PhD, as the Founder and Director of NeuroFaith®, does not provide clinical oversight, supervision, or direct involvement in the Therapist's care of clients, and is not responsible for the Therapist's clinical decision-making or services rendered.

The Therapist further agrees to ensure that clients are informed, in writing, that the use of the NeuroFaith® model within therapy does not constitute a supervisory, employment, or agency relationship between the Therapist and NeuroFaith® LLC.

The Therapist agrees to include language within informed consent materials indicating that clients acknowledge and accept that Dr. Jeffrey E. Hansen, PhD and NeuroFaith® LLC are not liable for the Therapist's clinical care, treatment decisions, or professional conduct.

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The Therapist agrees to obtain written acknowledgment of this disclosure from clients as part of the informed consent process and to maintain such documentation in accordance with professional and legal standards. Such documentation shall be made available upon reasonable request, consistent with applicable privacy laws and ethical guidelines.

### **Intellectual Property**

Dr. Jeffrey E. Hansen, PhD, as the Founder and Director of NeuroFaith®, retains full ownership of all NeuroFaith® intellectual property.

The Therapist is granted permission to utilize the NeuroFaith® model and associated materials in their clinical work, provided that such use remains consistent with the principles and standards outlined in this Agreement.

This Agreement does not create an employment, supervisory, or partnership relationship between NeuroFaith® LLC and the Therapist. The Therapist remains independently responsible for their clinical practice.
