PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

Dr. Jeffrey E. Hansen is a clinical psychologist, author, speaker, and founder of **NeuroFaith®**, an integrative framework exploring the intersection of neuroscience, psychology, and Christian faith in the healing of trauma, addiction, and the restoration of mind, body, and soul. Over more than four decades of clinical work in military medicine, pediatric psychology, and private practice, he has provided psychological care to children, adolescents, adults, and families while also developing innovative approaches to treatment that integrate contemporary neuroscience with enduring spiritual wisdom. His career has included leadership roles in major military medical centers, supervision and mentoring of clinicians and trainees, development of clinical training programs, and consultation with physicians, healthcare systems, and community organizations addressing complex behavioral and mental health challenges.

Dr. Hansen's work reflects a deep conviction that scientific understanding of the brain and the spiritual search for meaning are not competing domains but complementary pathways toward healing and human flourishing. Throughout his career he has trained clinicians, supervised graduate students and medical professionals, developed treatment protocols addressing trauma and addiction, and contributed to both professional and public conversations surrounding mental health, technology, and the human search for connection. Through his writing, public speaking, and professional consultation he continues to advance the NeuroFaith® model while encouraging a more integrated understanding of neuroscience, moral formation, and spiritual resilience in the restoration of the human person.
